OUR FOCUS

ADVOCACY

The SCA acts as the primary voice of the entire non-residential construction industry. We strive to represent the diverse interests of our members at the provincial level.

An important part of our advocacy efforts is the great work of our Advisory Council. The Council includes representatives from more than 20 industry associations from the non-residential construction sector, with a purpose to identify advocacy topics of common interest, to work together to establish common positions on these topics and to advocate those common positions.

Our advocacy work focuses on:

- Building relationships and partnerships,
- Developing industry expertise,
- Hosting Member Advocacy Sessions to advocate for industry interests,
- Building public support for the construction industry, and
- Attracting investment to Saskatchewan.

MEMBER SERVICES

The SCA makes it a priority to engage and build relationships with its members and five integrated partners. We strive to engage members and provide them with a competitive advantage through program offerings, communication and diversifying SCA's revenue streams.

Our member services work focuses on providing extraordinary value to our members through:

- Communications including social media, our website (www.scaonline.ca), quarterly *We Build* magazine, monthly e-newsletter and our *Membership Roster and Buyer's Guide* (print and online version),
- Networking events, such as our Annual Summer Meeting and our Awards Gala, and member sessions to keep our members up to date on current industry information, and
- Programs that will bring a competitive edge to our members, such as access to discounts and unique market benefits.

INDUSTRY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Skills shortages have been consistently identified as one of the most significant threats to the economic competitiveness of Saskatchewan's construction companies. The SCA's focus in industry workforce development is to provide a coordinated approach to support our members in finding the skilled workers they need to be successful.

Our industry workforce development work focuses on:

- Promoting construction as a desirable career,
- Gathering and sharing market intelligence,
- Connecting members with viable employees,
- Supporting retention of skilled employees, and
- Influencing public policy to advance Saskatchewan's construction workforce needs.

There are several components of this coordinated approach, some of which include providing members with up-to-date industry data, workforce development initiatives such as www.tradeupsask.ca, youth programs, scholarship funds, career fairs and more.
