



SKCA Board of Directors Meeting – February 11, 2021

SUMMARY

On Thursday, February 11, 2021 the Saskatchewan Construction Association (SKCA) held its first board meeting of the 2021 year. The meeting was held via Zoom.

Prompt Payment Legislation Update

Although the Government had previously issued a letter stating that the newly formed Saskatchewan Dispute Resolution Office (SCDRO) was the accepted authority on this legislation, SKCA received a letter from the Minister of Justice stating that the funding request for this authority must now proceed through the review process for the 2021/2022 budget cycle. The SKCA will take an incremental response approach to further push for the SCDRO as the official Authority and express the grave concern of delaying this legislation for another year.

Integrated Partnership

SKCA and local association COOs are meeting regularly to develop a “lean-in” approach to our integrated partnership, whereby staff will become interdependent with one another, sharing budgeting, operational planning, and management in an unprecedented way. A formalized plan will be presented to the Boards in April.

SKCA Events & Engagement Opportunities

The 4th annual Saskatchewan Construction Week will take place April 19-23, 2021. SKCA will be delivering a series of virtual sessions for members throughout the year; procurement sessions with infrastructure owners, economic updates with expert panels, and business advice with MNP.
