



## **SKCA Board of Directors Meeting – October 26, 2021**

### **SUMMARY**

On Tuesday, October 26, 2021, the Saskatchewan Construction Association (SKCA) held its fifth board meeting of the 2021 year. The meeting was held in person in Saskatoon.

This was the first meeting of the SKCA Board since the launch of the new lean-in partnership with all the integrated partner associations. As such, it featured reports to the Board from each of the members of the lean-in Executive Leadership Team (ELT): Kevin Dureau; Shannon Friesen; and Mark Cooper. Additionally, the SKCA Board was able to see the consolidated budgets of each of the partner associations when approving the SKCA budget.

The Board reviewed and approved the year-end financial statements for the SKCA, and answered written questions submitted by the SKCA's independent Auditor. The Board also received the CEO's report on the operational plan for the year that concluded on September 30, 2021. In looking forward to the 2021-2022 fiscal year, the Board approved the budget for the association.

During its roundtable discussion, the Board discussed recent increases to insurance rates within the industry and the impact this was having on member companies. The Board also discussed vaccine mandates and COVID protocols in the context of association events and meetings.

The SKCA is, with its partner associations, hosting a lobby day at the Legislature on Monday, November 29<sup>th</sup>. That day will include meetings with a number of Ministers and MLAs and a reception for all MLAs.

The SKCA Board will meet next on Thursday, December 9<sup>th</sup> in Regina. That same day, the SKCA Annual General Meeting will be held in Regina, at the Wascana Country Club, in conjunction with the Regina Construction Association's AGM.
